Member of the Bundestag Adis Ahmetovic is new rapporteur for the Western Balkans

A new role for Adis Ahmetovic, member of the German Bundestag and member of the Foreign Affairs Committee: He has been appointed by the SPD parliamentary group as rapporteur (BE) of the Foreign Policy Working Group for the Western Balkans. The region includes the countries of Albania, Bosnia-Herzegovina, Kosovo, Montenegro, Northern Macedonia and Serbia. As rapporteur for the Western Balkans region, Ahmetovic will prepare consultations on individual projects and policies and present proposals for decision-making by the Foreign Affairs Committee on behalf of his group. In addition, in his role he will be responsible for briefing the parliament.

"Internationally, we face major challenges and I look forward to the tasks ahead. Our goal is to translate the social democratic principles of peace and understanding into concrete action. I would also like to thank my parliamentary group for the trust they have placed in me," said Adis Ahmetovic. "The preservation of peace in Europe will be decided not only on the Ukrainian-Russian border, but significantly in the Western Balkans, explicitly in Bosnia and Herzegovina I want to work actively on stability and the preservation of peace in this region."

In addition to reporting on the **Western Balkans**, Ahmetovic will be responsible for covering the subject area of **Civil Crisis Prevention, Conflict Management and Networked Action**. He has also been appointed deputy rapporteur for the regions of **Russia, South Asia** (Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan, Sri Lanka), **Central Eastern Europe** (Croatia, Poland, Slovakia, Slovenia, Czech Republic, Hungary), as well as for the thematic area of **International Climate, Resources, Energy and Environmental Policy**.
